Payment Schedule

- A deposit is due at time of registration and is non-refundable.
- A second payment of \$2,200 is due by October 25, 2024
- \$2,200, or your total remainder, is due by January 10, 2025

If payment is not received by the due date, Sew & Sew Retreats is entitled to give written notice that your guest retreat reservation is cancelled. You, the guest, will **remain liable to pay the balance of the reservation unless we are able to sell the retreat space.**

Your place for the *Celebrate Hawaiian Textiles* retreat will be confirmed once receiving the nonrefundable deposit. Payment may be made by credit, debit card or PayPal. **Your confirmation email will include a Registration Form to fill out and submit.** This form must be completed when you receive it.

Registration

There are two steps you need to do for your registration to be complete. The first step is to pay the deposit. You will find a product listing for your selected retreat offering under "Pay" on the menu bar of the Sew and Sew Retreats website. You will receive a Thank You confirmation email once the payment has been received. **Your confirmation email will include a link to the Registration Form for you to fill out and submit.** This form, Step 2, must be completed when you receive it. When both steps are done your registration is officially complete.

We intend to create and follow a set itinerary. But due to weather conditions, health, teachers, tour professionals, construction and circumstances beyond our control, the itinerary is subject to change.

Passport

If you are participating in a retreat outside of the United States, a passport will be required. Your passport number and expiration date is requested on the Registration Form. Please be prepared to provide this information. Many countries require your lodging to provide them with your passport information.
